THE REDEMPTORISTS

9th of November. On this date in 1732 St. Alphonsus founded the Redemptorist Congregation. The Sunday nearest the 9th of November is designated as a day of prayer for The Redemptorist Missionary Vocation.

Day of Prayer for the Redemptorist Missionary Vocation:
We are all invited to pray in a special way today for the redemptorist missionary vocation. The Congregation exists *'to follow the example of Jesus Christ the Redeemer, by preaching the Word of God to the poor, as he declared of himself: He sent me to preach the Good News to the poor.'*

Currently, there are approximately 5000 Redemptorists in the world and they are spread over 80 countries, (95 in Ireland). There are now fewer Redemptorists in Europe and North America than formerly but there are increased numbers in countries such as Nigeria, India, Indonesia, Vietnam and Colombia.

Redemptorist Solidarity Fund: The collection this week-end (10-11 November) is for the support of Redemptorists in poorer countries and, more specifically, for the Formation of Redemptorist Missionaries in those countries. These are situated mainly in Africa, Asia and Latin America.

The Mass of Remembrance in St. Joseph's will be celebrated this year on Monday, 26th of November, at 7.30pm.

The Memorial of St. Laurence O'Toole is celebrated on the 14th of November (Wednesday). A native of Co. Kildare he studied in Glendalough, where later he became abbot. In 1162 he was chosen as the first native archbishop of Dublin. He reached out to the poor and abandoned. At the time of the Norman invasion he worked for peace and reconciliation. He died in Normandy in 1180 while on a mission of mediation with King Henry II and the Irish rulers.
