The World Day of the Poor: Pope Francis has designated the 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time as *The World Day of the Poor*, saying that it would serve as a way to prepare for the feast of Christ the King, who identified with the little ones and the poor and who will judge us on our works of mercy.

The special collection for the World Meeting of Families will be taken up this week-end. This collection is to help reduce the deficit of €4 million which is outstanding after the World Meeting of Families.

Pope Francis in his letter about holiness (Rejoice and be Glad) says: *The holiness to which the Lord calls you will grow through small gestures. Here is an example: a woman goes shopping, she meets a neighbour and they begin to speak, and the gossip starts. But she says in her heart: 'No, I will not speak badly of anyone'. This is a step forward in holiness. Later one of her children wants to talk about his hopes and dreams, and even though she is tired, she sits down and listens with patience and love.
