Redemptorist Reference: The feast of St. Alphonsus (1696-1787) is celebrated on the 1st of August. He founded the Redemptorist Congregation in 1732. He was canonized by Pope Gregory XVI in 1839, declared a Doctor of the Church by Pope Pius IX in 1871 and proclaimed patron of Confessors and Moral Theologians by Pope Pius XII in 1950. He was a prolific writer both of scholarly books (Moral Theology) and, also, of popular devotion (such as the Visits to the Blessed Sacrament).
