Pope Francis: *No one can strip us of the dignity bestowed upon us by the boundless and unfailing love of God. With a tenderness which never disappoints but is always capable of restoring our joy. He makes it possible for us to lift up our heads and to start anew.*

A hundred thousand welcomes? (extract from letter of Irish bishops): *We strongly encourage a 'culture of encounter' that goes beyond mere tolerance of newcomers. Such a culture fosters authentic participation and integration. Polite tolerance can leave migrants feeling isolated, but true Christian encounter involves mutual enrichment, where established communities and newcomers share and learn from each other. Pope Francis emphasises the need to engage with others deeply, not just seeing but truly listening and connecting with them. Church teaching affirms the dignity of every person – including that of the migrant – and reminds us that every person possesses inalienable rights and deserves respect and welcome.*

Aid to Church in Need is a group which supports persecuted Christians around the world, of whom there are about 360 million. We are invited to pray for persecuted Christians during this week and especially on Wednesday, 20th of November, which is called 'Red Wednesday', because red is the colour which represents martyrdom.
