Pope Leo in his recently published encyclical *Magnifica Humanitas*, states that the principles of justice apply to the church itself also. He says that living justice calls for 'purifying ecclesial relationships and structures from distortions that give rise to inequality, lack of transparency and abuse of power.' This means to listen to the victims of spiritual, economic, institutional, sexual and power-based abuse, as well as abuses of conscience.' Justice includes acknowledging the harm done, applying just reparation and taking steps to prevent it from happening again.

The Annual Concert *Sacred Summer Sounds*, presented by our senior choir, will take place in St. Joseph's on Sunday next, the 19th of July at 7pm. Tickets (€10 each) are available from choir members, at the monastery reception and may also be purchased at the church door on the evening of the concert. This concert is always a wonderful occasion.

The Annual Blessing of the graves will take place in St Patrick's cemetery Dowdallshill on Sunday 19th July @ 3pm. On the day, the graveyard will be closed from 11.30am until 1.00pm to allow for final preparations. We kindly ask the public to vacate the graveyard before 11.30am to allow for this.

After 1pm there will be no vehicular access to the cemetery apart from blue badge holders via the north gate until 2pm. We ask members of the public to please adhere to these times.

An Garda Siochana will oversee traffic, and we ask the public to please follow the instructions of the Gardaí and the safety stewards at all times.

We also ask attendees to have consideration for the residents in the area, when parking their vehicles.

As the event will take place outdoors, attendees are advised to dress appropriately for the weather and wear suitable footwear. Those who wish to bless the graves of loved ones are kindly requested to bring their own holy water. We hope that these measures will ensure that the day runs as smoothly as possible.
