The feast of the Most Holy Redeemer.

The Feast of the Most Holy Redeemer is celebrated on the third Sunday of July. The official name of the Redemptorists is *Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer* and, for that reason, today's feast is a very special occasion for Redemptorists. We celebrate today the great truth that Jesus, the Son of God is the Redeemer (Saviour) of the world. To fulfil this mission, He became human himself, born of Mary of Nazareth. As he lived out his mission, he shared with humanity the good news of God's love, mercy and compassion, the good news that he is the Way, the Truth and the Life, the who leads us on the road to salvation.

Pope Leo in his recently published encyclical *Magnifica Humanitas*, stresses the need to approach artificial intelligence with vigilance. He states that the most powerful technology is not necessarily the best one. AI can imitate and simulate the person, but it does not possess a moral conscience, nor empathy nor affective, relational and spiritual capabilities.
