**Pope Leo** in his recently published encyclical *Magnifica Humanitas*, reminds us that social justice requires fair access to opportunities for all people, protecting the most vulnerable, combating hatred and disinformation, and subjecting the use of technologies to public oversight. He says that the way society treats migrants reveals whether its sense of justice is driven by fear or by the spirit of fraternity. He appeals to societies to protect the rightful hopes of people forced to leave their country, to grant them a dignified welcome and to provide genuine paths to integration.

**Redemptorist Reference 1.** On the 7<sup>th</sup> of July 1871, Pope Pius IX confirmed the nomination of St. Alphonsus, founder of the Redemptorist Congregation as a Doctor of the Church. A Doctor of the Church is a person recognized for making an outstanding contribution to theology through their research, study, or writing.

**Redemptorist Reference 2:** on the 11<sup>th</sup> of July 1985 Fr. Rudy Romano, a Filipino Redemptorist, was captured and disappeared. He was a member of the then vice-province of Cebu, of which many Irish Redemptorists were also members.

**St. Moninne of Killeavy** is commemorated on the 6<sup>th</sup> of July (Monday). She lived in Faughart for a time and later founded a monastery on Sliabh Gullion. She was known to be a woman of great practical faith and charity. She died in 517.

**The Feast of Saint Benedict** (480-547)- is celebrated on the 11<sup>th</sup> of July (Saturday). The monastic tradition which he initiated had a significant influence of how Europe developed. He was named a patron of Europe in 1964 by Pope Paul VI.
