Twenty-Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Sunflowers: now is the time to save seeds for next year. The seeds form under the yellow flowers. When the back of the sunflower head turns from green to yellow or brown, the seeds are normally ready. Check that the seeds have formed, then remove the sunflower head and bring it inside to dry, maybe on a windowsill for 2/3 weeks. The head has dried out when it feels crunchy and the seeds can be loosened out. You can leave the head as it is or remove the seeds and store them in a paper bag for next year's plants. Please share seeds with others.
